FIFTH SUNDAY NOISY CHANGE OFFERING: Sunday, January 29 will be the 5th Sunday Noisy Change Offering. The offering will go to the Harvey County Domestic Violence/Sexual Assault Task Force (Safe House). This group provides services to victims and their children experiencing both domestic violence and/or sexual assault. In the last 12 months Safe House has provided services to over 1409 victims and their children. Safe House is considered a safe haven and provides services such as community resources, children resources, housing, employment, continued education, medical needs, financial budgeting, parenting, transportation, legal resources, substance abuse and basic needs. Domestic violence crosses all class, race, lifestyle, and religious lines. The only clear distinction is gender. DV is the leading cause of injury to women in the US between 15-44 years of age. Bring your change on Sunday, Jan. 29 to help this organization help women and children in Harvey County.

REWARDS PROGRAM: Salem is participating in a Dillons Rewards program. You may participate in this program by signing up your rewards card with Dillons. You may sign up on line at the Dillons web site or at the customer service desk in Dillons. Every time you buy using your rewards card 3% of what you spend is donated to Salem. At this point in time 14 families from Salem are signed up for this program and Salem makes an average of \$100 a quarter which is used for things like the food for the food pantry or meals for the homeless shelter.
