

#### Opportunity To Fellowship With Zimbabwe DS

A Zimbabwe delegation has come to the United States to thank their supporters and to attend the Great Plains Conference June 1-4. The Newton UMCs are hosting a reception May 28 at 3:30 at the community center of Asbury Park (the former chapel) for people to greet Mutare District Superintendent Rev. Daniel Chitsiku. Mutare is the district where Hutchinson District churches have partnerships.

In 2010 the former KS West Conference established a "Chabadza" covenant with the Zimbabwe East Conference. Salem has been in partnership since the end of 2010 with the King David circuit, currently served by Rev. Mriam Manyaya.

The Shona word Chabadza roughly translates to the English phrase, "working along side each other for mutual benefit." The Zimbabwe conferences are growing rapidly even as United States churches are struggling. Salem helps King David with some financial support, and each congregation promised to pray for their partner, King David can re-teach us how churches can still grow in the same way they did on the American frontier, by a high level of faithfulness and commitment, by passionate worship and active participation in small groups, and by building community and accountability.

#### From the Pastor

As United Methodists we are in connection with other United Methodists throughout the world. This may be most evident when we can respond to disasters, missions and such in bigger ways as a connected church than any one church could accomplish.

And of course this is evident when the pastor is gone for a few days to attend our Great Plains Annual Conference. This year that conference will be in Topeka from June 1-4. Judy Shifflet will represent Salem at conference as our Lay Delegate.

The worldwide nature of the church is also most visible with our General Conference held every 4 years, the most recent one ending May 20 in Portland. Here delegates from around the world gather as the only body able to change our Book of Discipline and other foundational documents of the church. Of the approximately 12.5 million members of the worldwide church, 5.5 (44%) million are now from outside the United States, largely Africa with about 5 million members (40%). While the membership in this country has declined roughly 900,000 in the last decade, the church in Africa has grown 3.3 million in that time period.

We will have an opportunity to acknowledge our worldwide church on June 12 with a special offering for our sister church, King David in Mutare, Zimbabwe.

It is good to be reminded of the worldwide connection we have to brothers and sisters in Zimbabwe, Philippines, Cuba, and Europe, to name just a sample. So our ministry at Salem is connected to ministry to churches all across the state of Kansas, the United States and the world. Take a moment in your prayer time to pray for your brothers and sisters in Christ!


