“Jesus Loves the Little Children”**“Praise the Lord, you his angels”** (Psalm 103:20)

Angels. . . what do you know about angels? Some people believe a number of myths about them. For instance, some people pray to angels, thinking they are on the same level as God himself. And some believe that people become angels when they die. But here's what the Bible, our authority, teaches:

- *God created angels (Colossians 1:15-17).*
- *Angels worship God (Nehemiah 9:6) and are known by these terms: archangels (Jude 1:9), cherubim (Ezekiel 10:19), and seraphim (Isaiah 6:1-3).*
- *They minister to God's people (Hebrews 1:13-14) by guarding and protecting them (Psalm 91:9-12).*
- *They are given special assignments by God (Matthew 1:20; Luke 1:26).*
- *God's angels rejoice when we repent of sin and turn to Christ for salvation (Luke 15:7, 10).*

Only God deserves our worship. So let's join the angels praising Him by making music!
