SUNDAY SCHOOL: The Double Duty SS Class will start back up on July 5th. Please read Matthew Chapter 8 in your Bible.

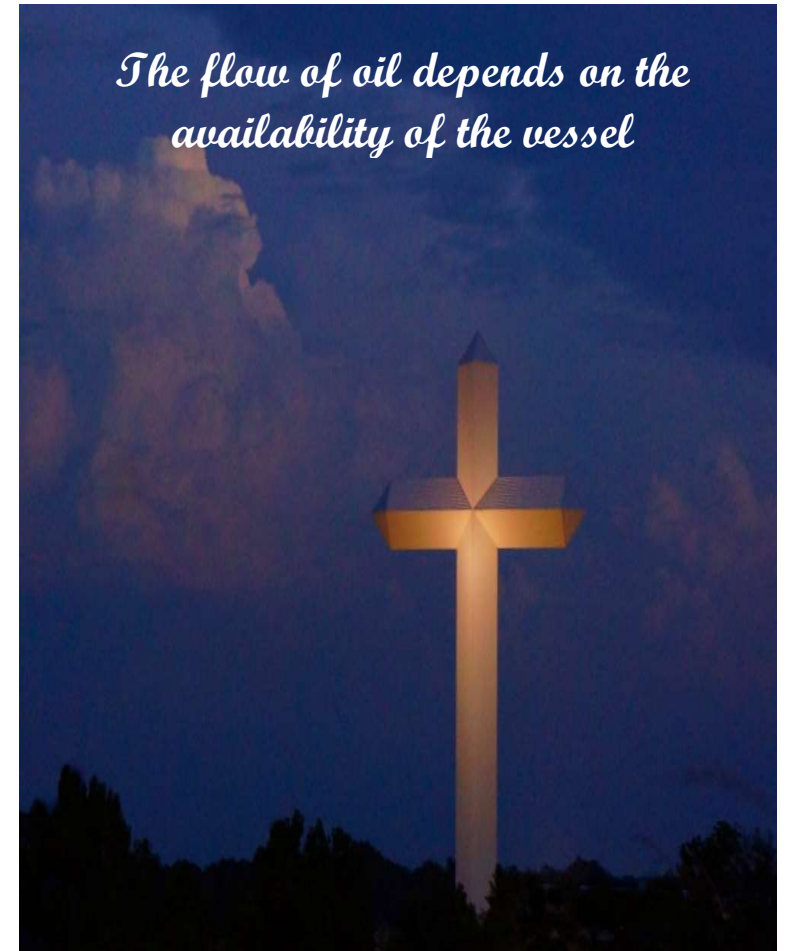
