Pastor's Column

Thanking You for Your Faithful Giving Greetings in Christ!

I wanted to take this opportunity to let you know how much we appreciate your faithful giving to the ministry of Salem United Methodist Church.

It is gifts like yours that continue to enable us to function as a healthy and vibrant church in both our community and worldwide. We desire to continue to reach out into our community with love and concern, but most importantly the Gospel of Jesus Christ! The work of the church could not go on without the consistent, generous gifts of God's people through Tithes and Offerings.

One of the greatest indications of our love for the Lord and His church is both our desire to give, as well as the action of giving. The Bible even gives us the story of Jesus sitting and watching the activity of giving. Most of us know the story of the "Widow's Mite" in Luke 21:1-4.
